**ADVANCED:** Competitive juniors will have the opportunity to improve fundamental technique, learn advanced strategic concepts, and participate in a competitive ladder.

**INTERMEDIATE:** Players with more experience will spend the summer honing their stroke technique and definition, gaining an introduction to beginning match play, and participation in games geared toward development as a player.

**BEGINNER:** Campers just starting out will learn the basic skills of tennis, gain experience in competition, and participate in games and contests that promote stroke development.
